**AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION  
BETWEEN  
MULAWARMAN UNIVERSITY  
AND  
KASETSART UNIVERSITY**

Mulawarman University, Samarinda, Republic of Indonesia and Kasetsart University, Bangkok, Kingdom of Thailand, recognizing the benefits to their respective university, from the establishment of international links, conclude this agreement.

1. The purpose of this Agreement is to develop academic and educational cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the two universities.

2. Both universities agree to develop the following collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

- 2.1 Exchange of faculty, researchers and other research and administrative staff
- 2.2 Exchange of students
- 2.3 Conducting collaborative research projects
- 2.4 Conducting lectures and organizing symposia
- 2.5 Exchange of academic information and materials
- 2.6 Promoting other academic cooperation as mutually agreed

3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this Agreement will be separately negotiated and agreed between the faculties, schools, or institutes, which carry out the specific projects. Both universities agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of their respective countries after consultation and approval.

4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in clause 2 may be restricted depending upon the availability of resources and financial support at the universities concerned.



5. Should any collaborative research activities under this Agreement result in any potential for intellectual property, both universities shall seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.

6. This Agreement may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both universities.

7. In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaboration activities in either country, both universities agree to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution.

8. This Agreement is valid for a period of five years from the date of signing by the representatives of both universities unless terminated or replaced with a new agreement. This Agreement may be extended by mutual agreement of the universities, which must be reduced to writing and signed by both universities.

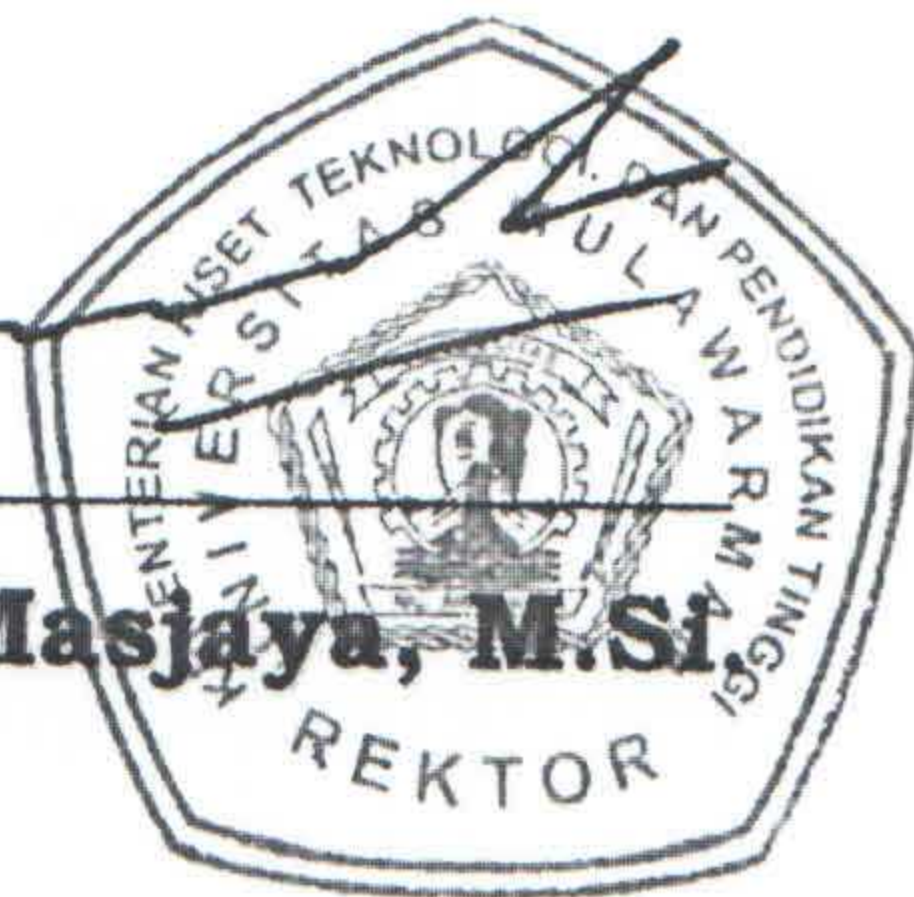
9. This Agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by either university upon written notice to the other university, which must be provided at least six months before the termination date.

10. This Agreement shall be executed in English.

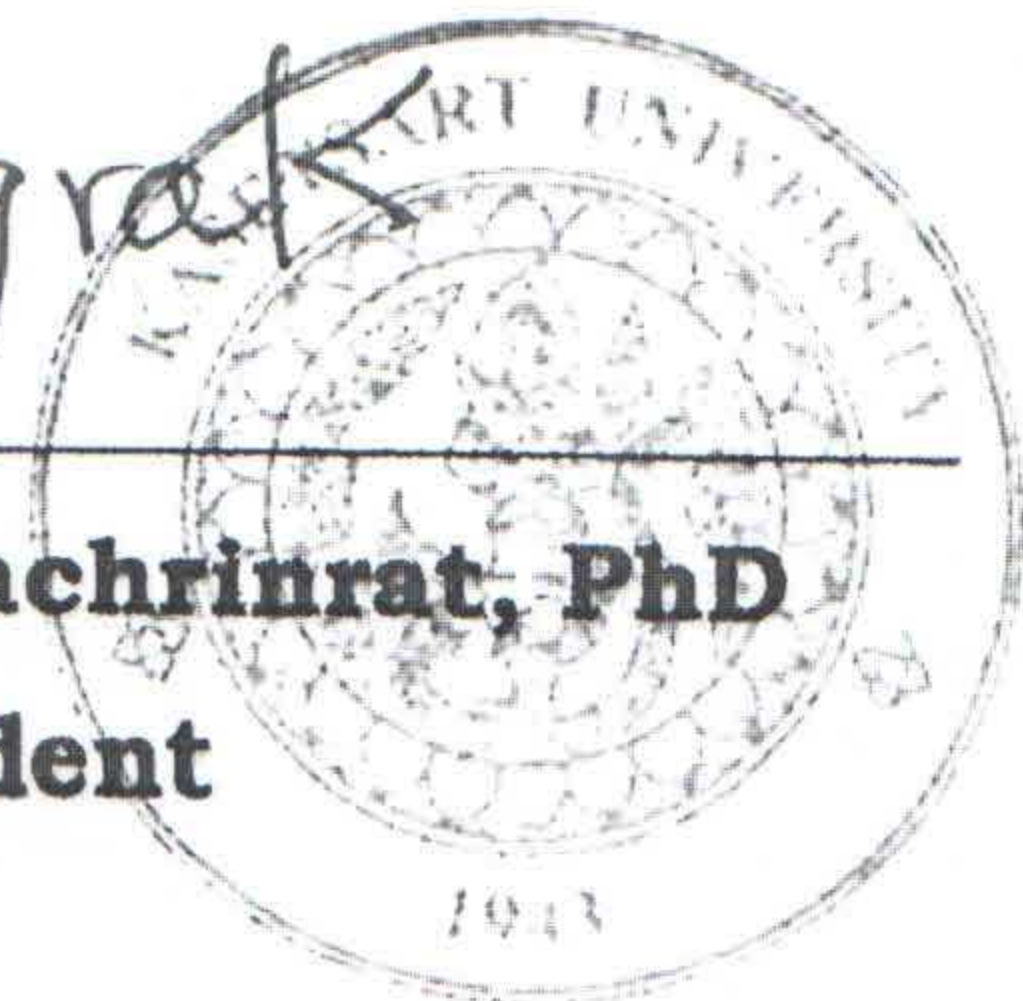

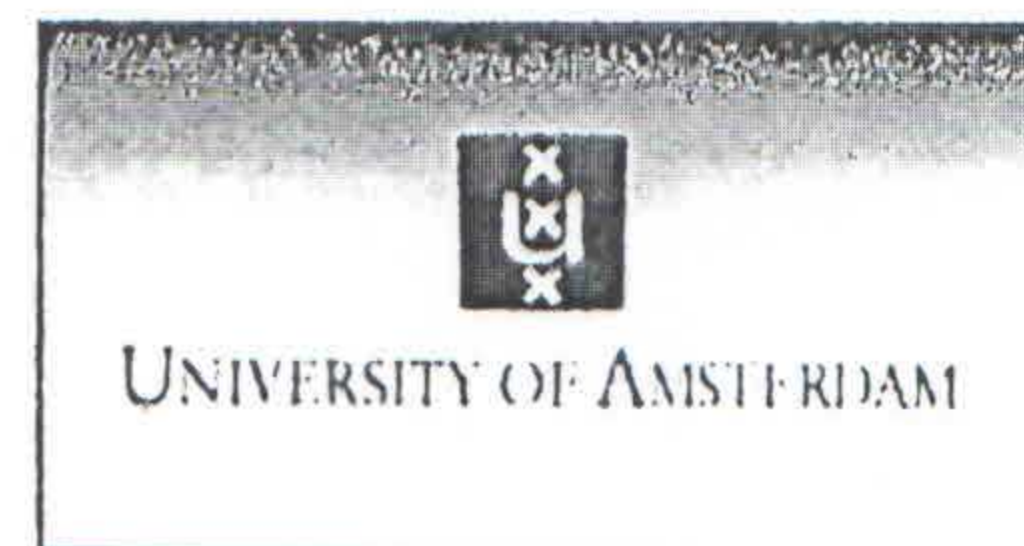



Mulawarman University and Aichi University**


Mulawarman University and Aichi University have agreed upon the following articles to develop academic and educational exchange.

2. The two universities will exchange their publications and other academic materials.
3. The two universities will consult on further possible academic exchange programs in other fields as well.
4. Specific written agreements to promote the above cooperation and exchange will be made after consultation and with due account taken of relevant individual circumstances.
5. This agreement shall remain in force for five years from the date of signature by the representatives of the two universities. The agreement shall continue in effect unless either party gives written notice to modify or terminate the agreement more than six months before the date of expiration.

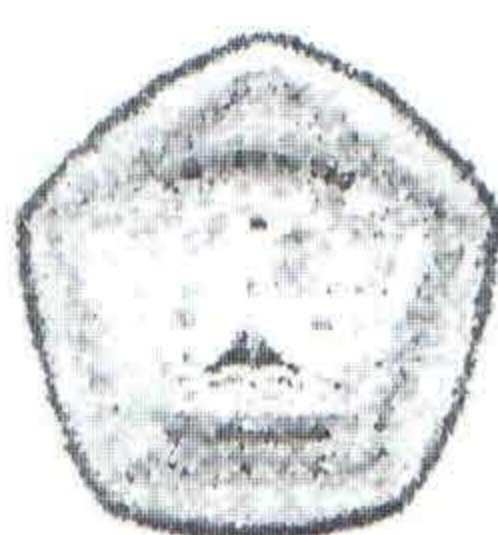

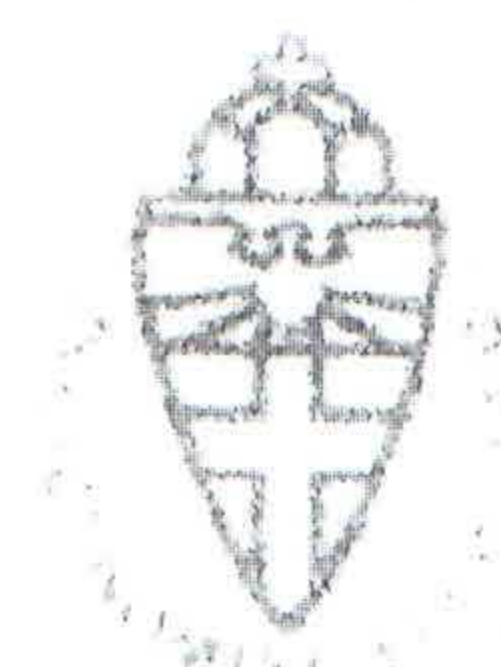
